Continued investment and realignment are key to the infrastructure for international business.

Working with the government, Cable Co, a Bermudian company, built the Challenger cable system and it has proven to be a critical piece of infrastructure for international business," added Munday.

As the local incumbent operator in Bermuda, BTC has been operating in the region for over 100 years. It says that through a maintained investment from KeyTech, the company is able to offer a range of services which include an advanced MPLS network, as well as international and local voice and Frame Relay capabilities. Its latest deployment meets high-



bandwidth requirements with the delivery of Ethernet services across the whole island.
